Dear parent/guardian,

Welcome back to all our learners, parents and staff. I hope all learners are well rested and ready for a very busy term 2.

Our school is already buzzing with laughter and excitement and it really warms my heart to hear and see all of this.

As we have quite a few short weeks ahead of us, it is extremely important that learners do not stay at home unnecessarily, I have noted that (despite sending communication several times last term) many learners were allowed to stay at home last term after the test series. I plead with you to not allow the learners to stay at home as we really need to ensure that all learners complete the curriculum in order for them to do well in the exams and tests. (This in particular happened with the high school learners.) No child can tell you there is no school unless you receive a letter via email/D6 connect/Whatsapp groups. After exams formal schooling will resume to complete all the term's work.

Our Grade 12 afternoon extra classes and Saturday classes will resume next week. All Grade 12's must attend these classes.

We will issue Term 1 reports to Parents only on Saturday (09 April 2022) from 08:00 – 10:00.
No learner will receive a report. Parents will sign that they have received the report.

Should you be unable to meet with your child's educator on Saturday, please ensure that you schedule a meeting for Monday – Thursday from 14:00 – 16:00 with your child's educator.

All learners should now have their school email addresses and be on Google Classroom. We will make use of Google Classroom on a regular basis as discussed previously. Quizzes will be done on Google Classroom as well, so please ensure that your child is connected. If you have any problems with Google Classroom, please email Mr S Botes (sbotes@royalschools.co.za) or myself (ebotes@royalschools.co.za) so that we can assist you.

I have noted that many parents are not registered on D6 Connect. Please ensure that you are registered (invites were sent via email last term). Many learners are on the WhatsApp groups instead of parents. This results in parents not receiving communication. Now for some exciting news:

- Rugby trials take place tomorrow in Kempton Park (invited learners only)
- Sports (Soccer, netball, volleyball and cross country) will start next week. Learners must wear the proper and correct sports uniform for sports practice.
