I am an ordained minister working in my church denomination for the past 33 years. I am also a school counsellor for the past twelve years. As a pastoral counsellor, I am able to provide spiritual guidance and therapeutic guidance to people in need of all ages and circumstances.

I counsel with appreciative diversity, empathy and compassion taking into account that each individual is special and unique and so are their needs.

I counsel with a hope-based approach. My counselling is aimed at empowering clients so that they can succeed in their life's endeavors.

I am a mother of two daughters aged 22 and 26 and this might be my best attribute to counsel learners of all ages as I mothered them through all the different school phases and ages.

How the process works:

There is a referral form to be filled in and handed to one of the principals.

These referral forms can be filled in by an educator and parent.

On receiving the referral form an appointment will be scheduled.

Parents or guardians of learners under the age of 12 have involved in the intake process and must sign consent the therapeutic process to continue.

Learners older than the age of 12 can sign assent for the counselling process.

Exceptions to the two points above are when it is an emergency situation.

My scope of practice includes the following:

- Assess the impact of spiritual needs on human health.
- Counselling from those suffering from chronic illness and addiction
- Develop and apply family enrichment programs within different cultures.
- Bereavement-grief counselling.
- Emotional well-being support.
- Relationship counselling.
- Anger management.
- Anxiety management.
- Trauma counselling.
- Address behavioural problems.
- Gender-based violence.
- Situational support.
- Learning support.
- Counselling children of divorced parents.
